## Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the Planning Commission Held on the 10th of July, 2019

### **Minutes:**

The draft minutes of the meeting of June 10, were reviewed. Member Haines suggested adding to the *Report of the Planning Commission* the specific intersection at where the waste hauler noise was occurring. Member MacLaurin moved that the minutes of the meeting of June 10, be approved with Member Haines suggestion. Member Waller seconded. The vote by was unanimous in favor.

### **Business:**

Continued discussion regarding noise

Discussion began with question how a proposed noise ordinance would be enforced in our small Village. Consensus was the Manchester Police Department would be the enforcer. The Commission felt a noise ordinance would be similar or the same as the Town of Manchester's. Without the Town's ordinance available at the meeting, the topic was tabled. Scott will research the Town's ordinance.

Review and update the Village Sign Regulations

Chair Brodie briefed the members on the Annual Meeting.

Member Haines briefed members on adding electrical outlets to the Village light posts on Main Street. The budget including the outlets was passed at the Annual Meeting.

Scott briefed the Commission on a solar zoning application that the DAC had heard earlier that morning. Discussion ensued. It was the consensus of the Commission that Scott should focus on a solar bylaw or ordinance and the Commission would revisit a noise ordinance at a later date.
