SPECIAL REPORT

President Campbell opened the meeting at 3:02 pm. It was noted a quorum was not present. As no vote was scheduled, the meeting proceeded as a work session as warned.

Line items under Highway Maintenance were each reviewed, discussed and proposed budget amounts were recorded for further consideration and vote by the BOT for ultimate approval by the Village of Manchester voters.

Ms. Johnson will follow up with the board regarding what is due under the Municipal Roads General Permit for the coming year, and will provided additional information on the cash carryover amount from 2020.

Trustee Lewis, who could not attend the meeting, previously provided input specifically relating to the tree budget. Continued discussion was had on the planting of trees this coming year.

It was suggested that the line item “Stonewalls” would be taken out of the budget. Some stone wall work relating to safety issues was suggested and will fall under “Miscellaneous, Sidewalk and Roadside Maintenance.”

At 4:23 pm, the list of line items under Highway Maintenance was exhausted. There being no further business before the attendees, the meeting was adjourned.
